



2022 COVID-19 Parent Agreement

As we continue to navigate our way through the pandemic, Mercer County Community College is consistently reevaluating our COVID-19 protocols. Below are the current conditions that parents will be required to agree to when completing a camper registration.

- I understand that MCCC is doing what the organization can do to prevent the transmission of illnesses and acknowledge that a healthy camper starts prior to their arrival at camp. Depending on the status of COVID-19 and availability of testing and vaccinations, we may encourage families to self-quarantine or limit exposures outside of their households prior to attending their camp session. Many resources that we have utilized to create and advise our COVID-19 policies share that, “a healthy camper starts at home.”
- I understand my camper could **possibly** be subject to the following, as a part of us working to keep everyone healthy: wearing masks most of their time at camp pending Health Department guidelines, reduced capacity, tracking of health for 14 days prior to arriving on-site.
- I understand if my camper or household member had direct exposure and/or tests positive for COVID-19, he/she must quarantine for 14 days prior to their return to camp. If your child cannot attend due to exposure Camp College will consider a refund based on medical documentation.
- I understand if my camper has symptoms, of COVID-19 or other contagious illnesses, she/he/ they will need to leave camp at my expense.
- I understand that if the camp staff believes a COVID-19 exposure has happened, my camper may be sent home.
- I understand if my camper needs to leave camp early for any reason (sports, family function, etc.) she/he/they will not be allowed to return.
- I understand I play a critical role in helping my camper understand that she/he/they need to adhere to the health protocols in order to help keep themselves and the camp community healthy.
- I understand I am sending my camper to camp knowing all precautions are being taken and if the occasion arises that an illness is transmitted, I will not hold MCCC responsible.

I understand my camper should not attend camp if:

*She/he/they are in a high-risk group category.

*We have a high-risk household member.

*Within 14 days a camp arrival she/he/they experience any symptoms of COVID-19 or other contagious illness.

*She/he/they will not be able to adhere to the necessary health protocols.
