Dear Camp Parents:

We're delighted that your child will be participating in our ECOVENTURE program. The information listed below will help you prepare for your child's adventure:

Daily Schedule (Please Read Carefully):

Campers should arrive at the West Student Parking Lot on time to allow for off-campus trips. The camp is scheduled from 8:30am-4pm. Please have your child in the West Lot no later than 8:15 with the exception of Ocean Fishing.

Wed., 8/4 Ocean Fishing, Atlantic Highlands, NJ Check-in 8am.

Thurs., 8/5 Sandy Hook National Park, Highlands, NJ

Fri., 8/6 Bucks County River Tubing, Delaware River, NJ

A certified school bus company will transport the campers to each destination.

What to Bring Each Day:

- Uncoated steel water bottle.
- Backpack or duffel bag and two trash bags.
- Suntan lotion, hat, bug spray, sunglasses for eye protection, and hooded windbreaker for rainy days.
- Old sneakers for wading in the water. Sturdy footwear. No flip flops or shower clogs.
- Mon. Aug. 2. Thurs. Aug. 5 and Fri. Aug. 6. campers should be prepared for swim with suits and towels. All campers should be able to swim and float.
- Mon. August 2 campers must wear closed toe shoes, preferably sneakers. No sandals, shower clogs, or flip flops are allowed while canoeing.
- Wednesday, Aug. 4 All equipment including fishing rods and bait are provided. Must wear sneakers or deck shoes.
- Lunch packed in insulated cooler bag with your child's name on it.
- Cold beverages, water bottles (individual frozen juice packs are ideal).
- ➤ NO GLASS BOTTLES, PLEASE!
- Face covering mask
- Ball of jute twine
- Small journal
- Plastic storage containers & zip-lock bags.
- Instructor will give you a list of household supplies that you will need on the first day of camp.

Other Materials and Supplies:

Bait will be provided but campers are welcome to bring their own or supplement it with some of their own "special" bait.

Medical Authorization:

There are no provisions to dispense medication for any off-campus program.
