

SEA CAMP: MARINE BIOLOGY & SHORE ECOLOGY AT THE BROOKDALE OCEAN INSTITUTE (AGES 10-14)



FULL Day

Discovery is the guiding principle behind this specially designed **one-week program**. Campers will have the unique opportunity of working with experienced environmental instructors in the outdoor “laboratory” of Sandy Hook and its surrounding waters. No prerequisites! Students will utilize scientific methodology to:

- Explore the chemical and physical properties of seawater
 - Study habitats available to coastal marine life
 - Assess the value of marshes and survey population densities
 - Collect and study deeper-water creatures, pollution, and human impacts of the sea
 - Investigate barrier beach botany
 - Examine the physical and geological features of water, waves, and beaches
 - Study topography, map and chart reading
 - Learn the historical significance of Sandy Hook, Fort Hancock, and the Twin Lights.
- Campers must bring lunch and snacks, bathing suits, sun block, beach towels, sneakers, rain gear and a hat. Tuition & fees: \$450. *Includes free optional before & after care.*
